DOOR POLICY

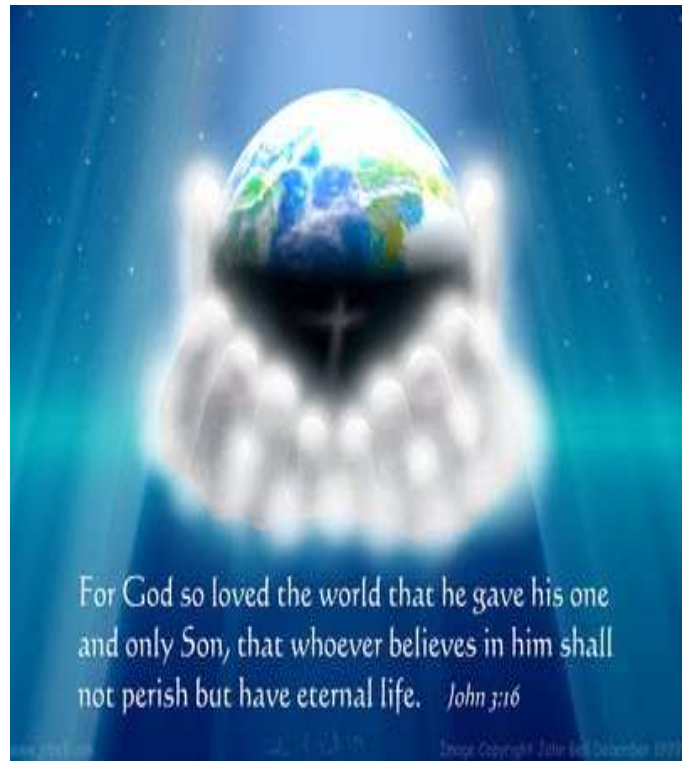
