4. Click on your name (top right hand corner), under 'Account Summary' scroll down to "Community Rewards"
5. Click on 'Edit' under Community Rewards
6. Under Find Your Organization: Enter the name of the organization or GP135 then select 'search'
7. Under 'Select Your Organization', click on the circle next to your organization.
8. Click on 'Enroll'

**If you have enrolled correctly, you will see the school name at the bottom of your receipts!**
