CHAPEL DRESS CODE

We have noticed that several students are using Wednesday as more of a dress down day rather than a dress up day. To help with this, I would like to remind you of what chapel dress means. We are allowing the girls to dress up in dress pants, a skirt, or a dress. Dress pants are defined as a loose-fitting, non-jean, dressy pant. Leggings that are not worn under a skirt or dress are not allowed. Tops need to be dressy without any wording on them. Dresses and skirts must be at least finger-tip length.
