ENROLL NOW FOR 2023-2024 SCHOOL YEAR OPEN HOUSE AND BOOK FAIR MARCH 3rd

2023-2024 Scholarships

Most of you are probably aware of the new Empowerment Scholarship that governor Ducey signed into action before he left office. With all parents being able to qualify for this wonderful scholarship, the school board has voted to raise our tuition so that we can keep up with the rising costs of supplies, food, maintenance, and wages. The new yearly tuition is:

 Preschool 3 day:
 \$2600

 Preschool 5 day:
 \$3200

 Kindergarten:
 \$5250

 1st - 6th grades:
 \$5750

After doing some research, these are still very moderate rates compared to other Christian schools. Parents of elementary students (K-6) have no need to worry about paying out of pocket for the tuition, because you can qualify for a 100% scholarship through the ESA Scholarship. Their 2023-2024 application process will begin in May. If you are already on the ESA Scholarship, you will get renewal information. For other families, we will be glad to help you with the process.

We have worked out the details, and our annual (minus 2020) Color Run will take place at Himmel Park. This event is a big fundraiser for our school, and we need everyone's support please. This year the funds raised will go toward painting and upgrading the building. We plan to do major improvements this summer like replacing all the flooring. Most of the funding is being provided by the church, but we need some more funds for painting. We are very excited about this much needed face lift. We are also very grateful for the funding.

We need each family to raise at least \$25 per student or \$40 per family, and your child will receive a Color Run t-shirt, sunglasses, and a color packet. If you can ask friends and family to support your child in the Run (walk) and raise more than \$25, that would be a major blessing. Any child who raises more than \$100 will attend a special ice cream party. The top fundraiser will be treated to a lunch of his/her choice which will be delivered to the lunch room.

To cut down on costs there will be no fundraiser packets that will go home or any website to go to. We will be billing each family for the \$25. Any other money that you can raise from friends and family, please send to school by check, cash, Zelle, or Venmo. Please make sure it is noted for Color Run. If anyone needs a receipt for tax purposes, we can provide that.

We will hand out the Color Run t-shirts the day before the event and the morning of. Please have your child wear their t-shirt so that all the students are in the same shirt.

We will be having a hotdog lunch. We would like parents to volunteer to bring the items needed for our family lunch. There will be a Sign Up Genius set up and will be available on March 7th. The link will be made available on Class Dojo.

We will need parent volunteers for this event. Please sign up or call the office if you are able to help. **We especially need about 7 men for security**.

We will be leaving the school to go to the park at 9:00 a.m. Please return the permission slip by March 10th. We hope you can attend this fun family event. Please be in prayer for this fundraiser.
